

ATTIRE POLICY

LAKESIDE PUB, SCREEN PORCH, AND OUTSIDE DECK

Appropriate golf and tennis attire defined by the Club rules are permitted in these areas. Swimwear cover-up attire is permitted. Hats and visors are permitted and should be worn forward at all times.

LAKESIDE MAIN DINING ROOM

Appropriate attire for men includes golf attire, collared shirts, slacks, or dress jeans. Appropriate attire for women includes suitable top with skirts, slacks, dress jeans, or golf attire. For men and women, no hats or visors allowed.

GOLF HOUSE PORCH

Appropriate attire for men includes golf attire, collared shirts tucked in, slacks, or dress jeans. Appropriate attire for women includes top with skirts, slacks, shorts or jeans. Leggings can be worn underneath skirts or skorts but not alone. For men and women, hats or visors are to be worn forwards at all times.

GOLF COURSE, DRIVING RANGE AND PRACTICE GREEN

All persons using the golf facility, including guests, children, and caretakers of children, must wear proper attire at all times. Men are to wear golf pants or shorts with tucked in collared golf shirts. Turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks are acceptable. Women are to wear golf pants, skirts, skorts, or shorts with collared golf shirts. Sleeveless shirts are acceptable provided they have a collar. Spandex pants or leggings are not permitted unless used as a layering piece underneath golf skirts/skorts. Shoes with soft spikes or spikeless shoes must be worn by all golfers. While sandals and heels are permitted in the Golf House, only flat bottom sandals are permitted on the course, practice green, and driving range.

The following are not permitted:

Tennis Shorts/Skorts/Skirts
Collarless Shirts or T-Shirts
Bathing Suits or Cover-Ups

Jogging Pants or Sweat Suits
Cargo Pants/Shorts
Denim Jeans/Shorts

Halter Tops
Tube Tops or Tank Tops
Camisole/Tennis Tops
